- b. Currently no RTAR submitted, John Scot presented RTAR in new format, the topic is Development and Validation of Space Conditioning, the Method of Load Calcs. Needs to be done by Aug'13 for submission in Sept'13. Variables (RH, DB Temp, Load Refrigeration and Load A/Conditioning) affect the integrated power consumption and quality of ice sheet. Don stressed the relevance to ASHRAE. John Scot mentioned that the consultants and engineers need the better defined load components. CFD and similar mechanisms of digitizing the load are required. Eg, data summary, regression analysis, formulating "what good shall look like"
- c. Pradeep Bansal suggested to prepare RTAR on arena space load started by Reinhold. WBorrowman, PKozlov, JScot are to assist. Tentatively teleconference to discuss the details and seek comments in Sept. Once prepared will have to be forwarded for submission to TC 10.8, for further input and co-sponsoring, comments and review.
